Elections for vacant southern seat on Girl's Basketball Executive Committee-

Jerrold Kauffman from Nolan Fieldhouse elected to fill seat by unanimous vote.

First order of business- Bid Procedure and tentative dates for 2005 Tournaments were approved:

Bid forms are due by **November 4th**. (they may be obtained online or by calling AAU Office)

Executive Committee will determine sites for each tournament and by **November 10th**- Proposed sites will be notified via email.

Bid Meeting- **November 20th** – 1:30pm at AAU Office. All Clubs who have been awarded a tournament must have representative there with confirmation of gym availability. If a representative of Club cannot be there tournament will be awarded to another club.

Rule Changes:

1. Starting 2006 Entry Fee will be raised to \$225.00 for all tournaments. – unanimous
2. Top 8 teams will be seeded in each age and grade level, based upon previous years results. Top 8 will be preplaced in assigned slots. - unanimous
3. All players , parents and coaches will be required to sign a code of conduct form before they will be allowed to participate in any AAU event. - unanimous
4. The Indiana District will pay \$325.00 ,per team, for all teams that qualify, and accept the bid, for the Division I National Tournament. If a team qualifies through the DQT but does not want to accept the bid, the bid will be passed to the next highest team at the DQT, up to the 8th spot. If a team gains a bid at the SRT but, takes the DQT bid instead , it can be passed on to the next highest qualifying team at the DQT. - unaminous
5. Participating teams will need to supply either a book-keeper (home team) or a clock-keeper (visiting team) at all AAU tournaments. Tournament host's have the right to waive this provision if they so desire for each tournament and/or game. 7-6 in favor

Rule Proposal's not passed

1. Have two separate tourneys for teams, one for teams that want to go to nationals, one for teams that do not want to go to nationals. Proposal died due to lack of second
2. Require shot clocks for all state finals events. Proposal died due to lack of second.
