

SUMMARY OF CHANGES 2007

Rule changes for Indiana program:

1. Only the top two finishing teams in each age group will receive \$325.00 for National entry fee. Regardless of Super Regional results.
2. Increase of admission fee for Saturday and Sunday sessions to \$5.00 per person.
3. There will be a \$150.00 entry fee for all teams that qualify and advance to the State Finals. If a qualifying team declines to advance, the next highest finishing team can advance. Teams will be required to sign a State Finals intent form prior to start of Regional. The entire \$150.00 will go to the Finals host to offset cost of officials, etc.
4. All Finals, including Grade Level finals, will follow the modified double elimination format used at the Age Group (Open) level finals.

National rule changes:

1. Reduce warm-up times from 15 to 10 minutes and half-time from 10 to 8 minutes.
2. Rename 16/u Division to “The Junior Division”; the 18/u to “The Senior Division” and the 19/u to the “Open Division”.
3. National Champ. Division II – Increase the number of “pick-ups” allowed from three (3) to five (5).
4. Once a team qualifies for a National tournament, the athletes on their roster cannot play for another team in the National Championship. If her team declines the bid and does not attend Nationals, she may be picked up by a team that is attending from her District or an adjoining District.
